The early part of his teaching career was in large comprehensive schools: his first post was at King James's School, Knaresborough, before he became Head of Sixth Form at the West Somerset School, Minehead. He moved to Harrow School, where, inter alia, he was appointed as Head of Geography and then House Master of Rendalls before becoming Deputy Head Master in 2004. In 2012, he became the founding Head Master of Harrow International School Hong Kong.
