GirlSpark Camp 2015 for aspiring young female technology leaders!

The Women's Foundation is partnering with Microsoft and Ivey Business School to hold our second ever 3-day GirlSpark Camp in Hong Kong. The camp will run from January 8-10, 2015 with an orientation session on January 2, 2015 and will be a unique opportunity for 60 female university students to explore first-hand career opportunities in the technology industry.

The 3-day programme will include presentations from IT and business leaders and a business case competition. Participants will gain an in-depth understanding of the technology industry and the variety of career options and development paths available for women. After the camp, selected participants will be offered internships at Microsoft.
