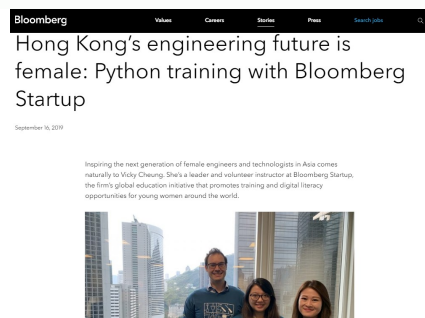
TWF PROGRAMME UPDATE
