# Advancing Gender Equality: The Key to Hong Kong's Inclusive Growth The upcoming Gender Equality Summit hosted by The Women's Foundation is a community initiative co-creating the future

For the benefits of gender equality to drive meaningful societal change, we need everyone to be involved, particularly those just starting their journey. The Women's Foundation's upcoming Gender Equality Summit: **Evolution through Exchange**, provides a vital platform for diverse voices to come together. Uniting a varied audience of approximately 300 thought leaders and changemakers, this meeting of minds marks the city as an incubator of progressive interchange on the regional and international stage.

Honouring 20 years of The Women's Foundation's operation in Hong Kong, the cross-sector event continues the organisation's mission — incubating the exchange of ideas, posing challenging questions, and ultimately driving meaningful action needed to co-create a Hong Kong where everyone thrives. Below are some of The Women's Foundation's achievements over the past two decades:

- 15,900+ underprivileged teens, their parents and teachers have been uplifted by our community outreach programmes
- 3,100+ secondary school girls have engaged with the world of Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics because of the Girls Go Tech Programme

- 700+ male allies were encouraged to harness their collective influence in the name of advancing gender equality
- 1500 mentors and protégés have advanced their leadership skills through our best-in-class and cross-industry Mentoring Programme

Supported by lead sponsor Bloomberg, the **Evolution through Exchange** summit will commence on September 13, 2024, at HKEX Connect Hall. The summit welcomes attendees from non-profit organisations, businesses, academic institutions and the public sector. By providing a platform that reaches across demographics, the summit facilitates dialogues that might not happen in the outside world, encouraging the collaborative development of practical solutions to gender inequality.

In addition to celebrating the progress made in Hong Kong over the last 20 years, the summit will be vital in capturing actionable takeaways to further promote inclusivity and a brighter future for all in Hong Kong. After the summit, we will draw on the unique insights generated to create the **Hong Kong Gender Advocacy Map** – a first-of-its-kind guide laying out best practices, sparking new ideas, and encouraging collaborative, multi-stakeholder efforts.

#### **Evolution of the Workplace (Panel)**

In the face of ongoing talent shortages, rapid technological developments, ageing demographics, and workforces with diverse needs, employers must think differently to attract, develop, and retain top talent. Speakers on the panel will discuss key employer considerations to address evolving workforce challenges and the role gender and inclusion play.

### Redefining Leadership (Fireside chat)

This fireside chat will draw on learnings and insights from two highly successful female leaders, exploring various aspects of what defines leadership today and identifying essential leadership qualities needed to guide organisations through complexity.

#### **Evolution of the Home (Panel)**

This session focuses on the domestic sphere, examining changing gender roles, shifting gender expectations, and health taboos.

#### **Exploring Masculinities (Fireside chat)**

Globally, there's been a concerning rise in misogynistic ideologies, pushing back against progressive gender norms and shifting power dynamics. This session will explore multifaceted aspects of masculinity from gender-specific struggles facing men to violence against women - ultimately charting a course for a reimagined, inclusive conception of masculinity.

#### **Evolution of Education (Minute Messages)**

As we work to create a thriving society, Hong Kong must grapple with a range of sensitive yet crucial topics like comprehensive sex education, mental health support and dismantling systemic inequities. Speakers will respond with their ideas around a central question: What elements of education should be reimagined to foster a more inclusive, equitable society for all?

#### **Evolution of Society (Panel)**

Society's foundations continue to transform at an increasingly rapid rate. From the challenges of ageing populations to the rise of AI and other emerging technologies – this panel will explore how we can ensure equitable access and opportunities for people of all ages.
